The Kingsley Association has been an integral part of our community since its establishment in 1893 for the purpose of providing services to working class ethnic families of Pittsburgh. Over the years we have evolved into a community HUB, focused on family programming, health and wellness and community involvement. The Kingsley Association works diligently to provide comprehensive, culturally relevant, educational, recreational, and social programming that positively impacts the lives of youth, their families and the East End communities and beyond. Through our work we have become a vital thread in the fabric of these communities.

Our membership provides unlimited access to our fitness facility, group exercise classes, health and wellness programs, swimming pool and gymnasium. Our rates are well below market value, ensuring that individuals and families in our neighborhood can take advantage of these opportunities.

A wide range of community groups, individuals, local organizations as well as The City of Pittsburgh and Allegheny County use The Kingsley Association as their base of operations or regular meeting space as well as a venue for important community-wide informational meetings. As such, we provided in excess of \$170,000 in subsidies and discounts.

Our Family Support program has served an estimated 225 families in need, focusing on stabilizing and empowering the family environment. Additionally, our case management staff has successfully supported 155 Choice Neighborhood Initiative families in navigating relocation challenges, other housing related obstacles.
